## Message from NHA President MIKE GALLAGHER

### Holiday Recovery Time has Arrived!

Now is the time we finally get to return to normal days without worrying about holiday decorations, cards, gifts, and parties. What a relief. As we mentioned in the last newsletter, all of us must get started on our “to do” lists for 2024.

A good place to begin is by marking our new calendars with meetings and events set for this year. In Northern Hills some of those activities include **NHHA General Membership meetings** on February 20th, May 21st, August 20th, and November 19th. This year we will be holding these big meetings at 6:30 p.m. at the Northeast Senior Center, near our Northern Hills main entrance, at 4135 Thousand Oaks, off Scarsdale.

Some other important activities include our **Neighborhood Garage Sales** on May 4th, and October 5th, and our **Neighborhood Clean Up Days** on May 11th, and October 12th. We also await the announcement from the City on the next **Neighbors Together (NT) program** which we anticipate will be held on October 1st at the NE Senior Center. Last year's NT event was a lot of fun and I hope we can do it again this year. We will keep you updated on any date or venue changes for these events.

Another priority on my list, and I hope on yours, is to begin getting rid of all those unneeded items (also known as junk) in our homes and garages. They include old and ignored items such as furniture, books, magazines, clothing, shoes, dishes, blankets, rugs, towels, paint, expired medicines, worn out appliances, etc. The list goes on and on. Many of these things can be donated to charities including Goodwill, Habitat for Humanity, and Salvation Army. You can go on line or look in the yellow pages (remember those?) for a listing of local charities and the types of items they want donated.

If we are having to park our cars or trucks outside of the garage because it's packed with stuff, a good question to ask ourselves and family would be, “Is that stuff worth more than our vehicle?”. Usually the answer is “NO”. Items start piling up in the garage and around the house when we fail to make a decision on what we should save and what we should get rid of. Another good solution is to establish a rule that if we buy something new, we should immediately get rid of the old one being replaced.

Our “to do” lists should also put a priority on home and neighborhood security and upkeep. For example, if a house appears that the residents are not there, it becomes an invitation for a possible break-in. Security lights, cameras, warning signs, and our dogs can all be methods to scare off the bad guys. If you are going to be away from your home for an extended period of time, you should ask your neighbors for help. That includes picking up newspapers, packages, and your mail. Also, plan on having someone mow your lawn if you will be gone for more than two or three weeks.

We heard some good news for 2024 from some of our wonderful neighbors. On their “to do” lists, they intend to give a donation this year to the Northern Hills

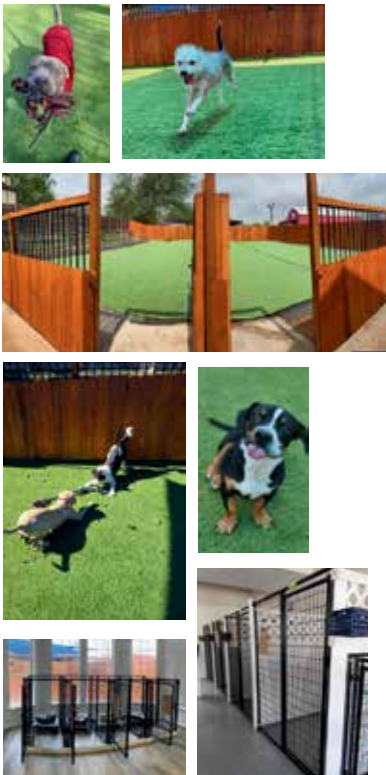

He has faced a challenging life because he is blind; however, his condition hasn't stopped him from having a very active life and sharing his positive attitude through his writings and conversations with so many of us.

### A New Chapter

by Larry Johnson (age 90)

Life is not over when you hit 70. It's just beginning.

You've raised your children, retired from your job and have lots of time on your hands. So what do you do with it?

You can sit in your rocking-chair and listen to audio books or podcasts. You can reminisce nostalgically about the good old days while sipping a cup of ginger root tea.

Or you can use your knowledge, experience and talent to teach the public, especially young people, how to help create a friendlier, kinder environment for people who are blind or have low vision.

Because you have faced and overcome dozens of challenges throughout your life, because you have made mistakes and learned from them because you have succeeded after failing, gotten back up after falling, you are an example, a role model for others.

Do not discount your value, withhold your wisdom, hesitate to help. You have the opportunity, and the responsibility to



give back to your community, to the world, in whatever way you can, the knowledge and experience which you have acquired over the years, and to do so with joy and enthusiasm.

Your life is not over. You have just begun a new chapter.

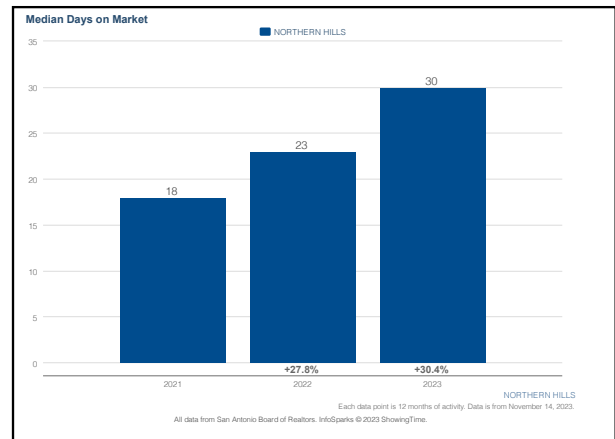
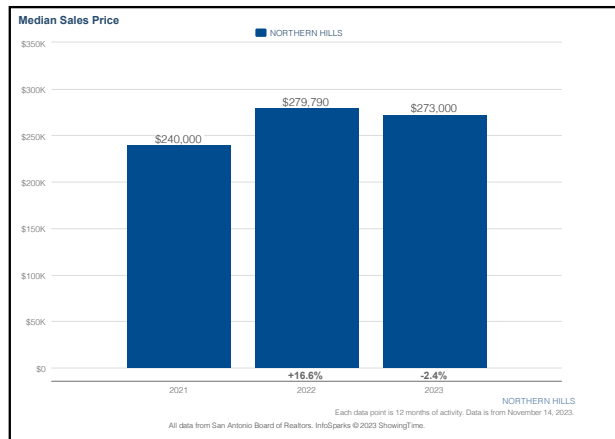

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
