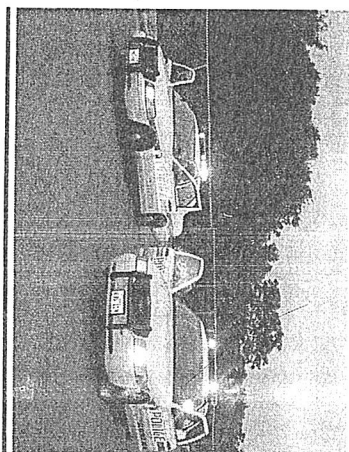
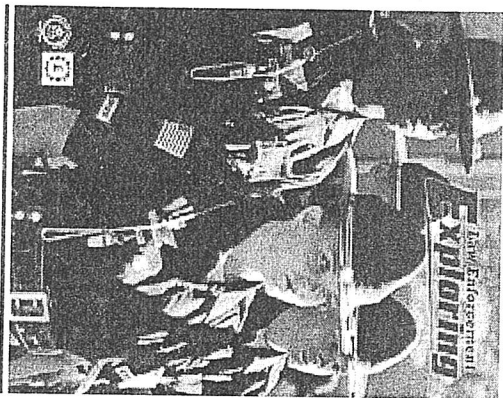


WHAT IS LAW ENFORCEMENT

EXPLORING?

Law Enforcement Exploring is a part of the Boy Scouts of America. It is designed to acquaint young people with the nature and complexity of Law Enforcement. The purpose is to:

- Develop good citizenship
- Teach youth about the duties of Police Officers



WHAT WILL WE DO?

Explorers learn basic police procedures, techniques, and tactics.

Explorers receive training in many areas of law enforcement such as conflict resolution, traffic stops, physical training, self-defense, and radio procedures.

Explorers also learn about crime prevention and investigation of criminal activity.

Explorers participate in community service by assisting with traffic and crowd control during Fiesta and other public events.

Explorers engage in competition with other explorer posts to demonstrate their skills, leadership ability and teamwork.

Explorers sponsor fundraising activities as well as social events to enhance team development.

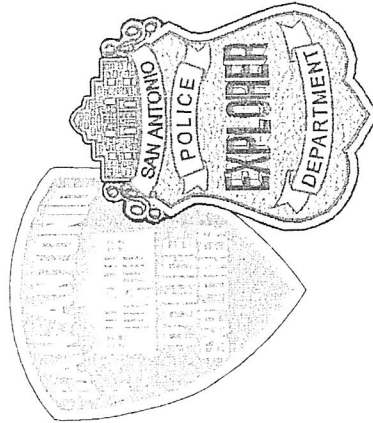
HOW DO YOU QUALIFY?

Both male and female young adults are encouraged to join Explorers. To join you must meet the following criteria:

- Be between the ages of 14 and 21 and have completed the 8th grade
- Have a sincere interest in law enforcement
- Be enrolled in school and maintain a "C" average
- Have parental permission if under the age of 17
- Have no serious police record
- Be in good health
- Maintain a neat appearance and manner in compliance with the policies of the department
- Pass a thorough background check
- Complete the Basic Explorer Training Program

WHEN DO WE MEET?

- North Explorer Post meets Tuesday evenings at the North Substation.
- Meeting times are from 1800 to 2100 hrs.
- Members are expected to regularly attend meetings.
- Uniform/dress code will be strictly enforced.
- All Explorers are required to bring mandatory equipment to each meeting.
